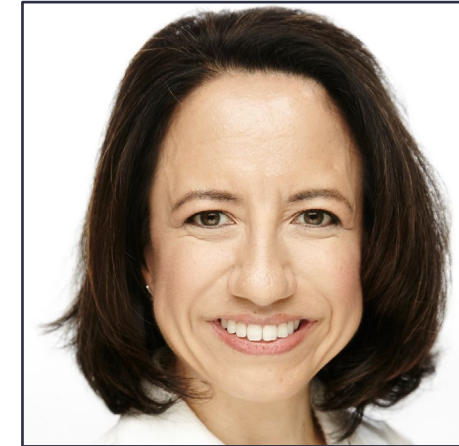


SPEAKER BIO

Sandra J.H. Rolnicki, PhD, is an Assistant Vice President at the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco in Supervision + Credit. She leads a team of risk management professionals who are focused on the assessment and governance of risk in the 12th District's portfolio of Regional, Community and Foreign Banks. Their responsibilities include direct examination work, surveillance, outreach, and applying emerging technologies. Team members also participate in Federal Reserve System and interagency working groups to help shape the future of bank supervision.
